Basic Pistol Proficiency is based in handgun fundamentals and oriented toward defensive use of the weapon. If you have no experience, or 40 years of experience, you will come away with greater confidence and a better understanding of your ability! He/she will learn the basic gun-handling skills and advanced necessary to safely operate, and maintain, this weapon system. Instruction will include the deployment and application of this platform for personal defense.

Machanical & Shotgun Breachers Course

The aim of this 4 day course is to qualify select personnel as Mechanical & Ballistic Breaching Instructors. Students will be versed in the correct and safe use of manual breaching tools as well as the 12 gauge breaching shotgun. Additionally they will be afforded the opportunity to plan, prepare and present lessons pertaining to these subjects. On successful completion of this course, the students will have the necessary knowledge in order to educate their peers in this skill set.

SWAT Officers deploy a training diversionary device.

The Basic SWAT course is designed to provide law enforcement students with an understanding and application of Basic SWAT tactics, techniques and procedures during critical incidents. Students will be exposed to common SWAT missions such as High Risk Warrant Service, Barricade Persons, and Hostage Rescue tactics. The course will provide lecture and demonstrations with scenario-based exercises.

Pre-requisite: Certified Peace Officers / Active Duty Military – This course is hosted based on current TCOLE Standards. There will be a pass/fail physical assessment the morning of the first day of class. Students should show up for class in PT gear -bring clothes to change after. Students failing the physical assessment receive a certificate of attendance rather than a certificate of completion. The PT test is the Cooper “Single Cut-Point” standard: 1.5 mile run in 16:28, 300 meter run in 1:11, 25 push-ups in 1 Minute, 29 sit-ups in 1 minute.

Equipment: All normal tactical equipment including, BDU or other similar tactical uniform, PT clothing, body armor, load-bearing vest or web-gear, eye and ear protection, gas mask, handgun and/or shoulder fired weapon (400 Rounds Rifle/400 Rounds Pistol). Please bring Simunitions / UTM safety equipment and 50 Simunition / UTM rounds.

It is the only TCCC course endorsed by the American College of Surgeons. The TCCC-MP (TCCC for Medical Personnel) course is designed for combat EMS/military personnel, including medics, corpsmen, and pararescue personnel deploying in support of combat operations. NAEMT's TCCC course is accredited by the Continuing Education Coordinating Board for Emergency Medical Services (CECBEMS) and recognized by the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT).

EMT BASIC Certification and above. This course will utilize live fire and force on force drills, students must be in good physical condition.

SOF Tactical Medical Refresher (SOF TMR / ATP & Paramedic Refresher):

Meets the training requirements of the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) for recertification of the **Paramedic** and the USSOCOM **Advanced Tactical Paramedic (ATP) certification**. Designed to meet the skills sustainment of the EMT-P, as well as **senior medics of the military** - Army 18D, Air Force Pararescue, Marine Corps Amphibious Reconnaissance Corpsman, Navy IDC, and SPECWAR SEAL.
